BOOK CLUB QUESTIONS

1. Libby resolves to support Ludo in the face of his crime for the sake of her family. How would you have reacted if you found yourself in Libby's position?
2. The novel's title is *The Good Woman's Guide to Making Better Choices*. What choices could Libby have made better? What choices does she avoid making?
3. What role do close friendships play? How do they influence the story in large and small moments?
4. Loyalty is a key theme throughout the novel. What characters apart from Libby demonstrate loyalty in different ways?
5. There is a strong sense of community throughout the novel. What role does community play in shaping the thoughts and actions of Libby, Harrison, and Alexi?
6. Ludo proves himself to be hugely duplicitous at the climax of the novel. In what ways do some of the other characters demonstrate duplicity?
7. What role does sibling dynamics play in shaping some of the characters?
8. Which character do you admire the most? Who do you most relate to?
9. Did the book end the way you thought it would? What parts did you guess? What didn't you guess?
10. Who would you cast in the roles of the main and supporting characters in the movie adaptation of *The Good Woman's Guide to Making Better Choices*?
