Matters go from atrocious to worse when her possessions and home are repossessed, Libby is sacked and a priceless family heirloom is wrecked. While camping out at the rural goat farm where she was raised, Libby is forced to re-evaluate her life choices. How will she crawl out of financial ruin? Was Maya more than a business partner to her husband? And, most importantly, how will she save her family from falling apart?

In 2016, Liz was recovering from breast cancer surgery and found herself frustrated at the endless hours spent resting, until her husband finally suggested she write a book. After taking a few courses and developing an appetite for creative fiction, *The Good Woman's Guide to Making Better Choices* was born.

A charming, page-turner debut novel, **The Good Woman's Guide to Making Better Choices** celebrates the power in starting life over again when everything goes south, and the surprising possibilities that present themselves when all hope seems lost.
